

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-179 C.S.**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY**

**DECLARING CANVASS OF RETURNS AND RESULTS OF CONSOLIDATED  
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020**

WHEREAS, a Consolidated General Municipal Election was held in the City of Monterey on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, in accordance with law, and pursuant to the Council's adoption of Resolution Nos. 20-087 and 20-088 C.S. on June 16, 2020, calling for, and requesting consolidation of, the election for the purpose of electing the following municipal officers of said City:

A Mayor for the full term of two (2) years;  
Two (2) Councilmembers for the full term of four (4) years, each;

WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 20-121 C.S. on August 4, 2020, for the purpose of submitting the following City of Monterey measure to the qualified voters of the City on the November 3, 2020 ballot:

Ballot Measure Y, "Hotel Tax Measure," asking the voters of the City of Monterey to approve an increase of transient occupancy tax (hotel tax) from 10% to 12% on the cost of rooms paid by hotel guests, with 16% of proceeds allocated to the Neighborhood and Community Improvement Program, and 84% to essential services such as parks, recreation, library, emergency response, facility rehabilitation, and other unrestricted expenditures, and expanding the tax to apply to online travel companies, providing \$2.8 to \$5.6 million annually, effective until repealed by voters;

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed and in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of Charter of the City of Monterey and the Elections Code of the State of California;

WHEREAS, the votes received at said Consolidated General Municipal Election were received and canvassed and the returns thereof were ascertained, determined and declared in all respects as required by law;

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Elections Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, and the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A,"

WHEREAS, The City of Monterey determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CCR, Title 14, Chapter 3 ("CEQA Guidelines), Article 20, Section 15378). In addition, CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 includes the general rule that CEQA applies only to activities which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the

activity is not subject to CEQA. Because the proposed action and this matter have no potential to cause any effect on the environment, or because it falls within a category of activities excluded as projects pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378, this matter is not a project. Because the matter does not cause a direct or any reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change on or in the environment, this matter is not a project. Any subsequent discretionary projects resulting from this action will be assessed for CEQA applicability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY as follows:

1. That the City Clerk is hereby instructed to enter on the records of this City Council this Resolution as a statement of the result of said election.
2. That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City of Monterey in said Consolidated Election was 14,581.
3. That the list of candidates nominated for the offices hereinafter set forth were the names of the candidates, which were set forth in the petitions assembled and filed with the City Clerk, as required by law.
4. That the total number of votes cast in favor of each of the candidates is listed as follows:

Shall the measure be adopted to increase transient occupancy tax (hotel tax) from 10% to 12% on the cost of rooms paid by hotel guests, with 16% of proceeds allocated to the Neighborhood and Community Improvement Program, and 84% to essential services such as parks, recreation, library, emergency response, facility rehabilitation, and other unrestricted expenditures, and expanding the tax to apply to online travel companies, providing \$2.8 to \$5.6 million annually, effective until repealed by voters?</p>	YES

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does declare and determine that Clyde Roberson was elected Mayor for the full term of two years, Dan Albert was elected Councilmember for the full term of four years, and Alan Haffa was elected Councilmember for the full term of four years, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized to immediately deliver to Clyde Roberson, Dan Albert, and Alan Haffa a *Certificate of Election*, signed by the City Clerk and authenticated, and to administer to each of said elected persons the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California, and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election:

More than two-thirds of the voters voting on Ballot Measure Y, "Hotel Tax Measure," asking the voters of the City of Monterey to approve an increase of transient occupancy tax (hotel tax) from 10% to 12% on the cost of rooms paid by hotel guests, with 16% of proceeds allocated to the Neighborhood and Community Improvement Program, and 84% to essential services such as parks, recreation, library, emergency response, facility rehabilitation, and other unrestricted expenditures, and expanding the tax to apply to online travel companies, providing \$2.8 to \$5.6 million annually, effective until repealed by voters, did vote in favor of it and that the measure was carried and so shall be deemed adopted and ratified;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
